## SYNOPSIS

From the executive producer of 'Bull Durham' and 'White Men Can't Jump' comes **SPACEMAN**, the mostly-true story of former all-star MLB pitcher Bill 'Spaceman' Lee. In the twilight of a long career as one of baseball's all-time great eccentrics, Lee (Josh Duhamel) is cut from the Montreal Expos in 1982. Though Lee finds himself blackballed by the rest of the league for his outspoken politics (his views being "somewhere to left of Che Guevara") and notoriously enthusiastic drug use, he refuses to quit the game. As of 2016, he still hasn't.

## DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

In 2003, I directed a documentary about Bill "Spaceman" Lee, which followed him to Cuba for a week and showed him barnstorming the country, playing ball at age 57 against a bunch of Cuban legends. Along the way he also told the story of his life and colorful career. When the film was edited, I always got chills watching Bill talk about the transition from professional baseball star, to unemployed, to accepting that he could play in a senior league. He would say, "I never quit playing," as if it was never even a consideration...because it wasn't.



His was such a punk rock anti-establishment perspective. I wanted to dig deep into that turning point in his life and surrender of ego that has allowed him to play even now as he approaches seventy. I wanted to recreate the actual arguments with managers, the conversations with friends and family, and the ultimate triumph.

**SPACEMAN** is a dark comedy biopic with sports as the setting. It ranges from some pretty silly and fun physical comedy to heartfelt moments that show a man dealing with his identity and familial struggles. Films that have any sports in them tend to get shoved into the "sports" genre, but we think this story is much more universal.

Some people know Bill as an eccentric druggie pitcher from the 70's with a cool nickname, but he is so much more than that. There is a character in mythology known as the "Holy Fool." It is someone who everyone writes off as foolish, but it turns out he is the smartest of them all and often the most genuine. Bill is the "holy fool" of baseball – he is a product of the 60s who was actually far more intelligent than he was eccentric. He got the nickname "Spaceman" because he was talking about the space program in the locker room when we landed on the moon. He was talking about the environment, yoga, and organic food far before it was fashionable to do so. Baseball locker rooms are typically not the setting for much intellectual discourse.

Josh's athleticism, genuine charm, and range make him perfect for this role. We also have a supporting cast that's a combination of incredible actors including W. Earl Brown, Sterling K. Brown, Caroline Aaron, Winter Ave Zoli, Ernie Hudson, and a ton of others. Everyone involved took part because they loved the script; I think they could really feel the love we had put into it.

I hope this movie leaves people entertained first and foremost. So many current films are either sequels or genre movies, and I understand why given the marketplace, but this film is truly original and a throwback to the kinds of movies that used to get made.

SPACEMAN is the story of a man reinventing himself and I think its moral is universal: life is a personal experience and we need to tune out the crowd and define what we want our lives to be for ourselves. On a personal level, I hope that our making this film inspires those who have a vision to start something, whether it be a movie, a novel, or a rose garden. No one asked us to make a film; we just did it.

## CAST

### JOSH DUHAMEL

A dynamic and versatile actor, Josh Duhamel is one of Hollywood's leading males. Most recently, Duhamel was seen in J.J. Abrams, Joseph Boccia and Athena Wickham's Hulu mini-series, "11.22.63", and Shintaro Shimosawa's *Misconduct*. Duhamel recently completed production on Giancarlo Esposito's *This is Your Death* and is currently in production on *Transformers: The Last Knight*. Duhamel will next be seen in Brett Rapkin's, *Spaceman*, premiering in August 2016.

Duhamel starred opposite Julianne Hough in Lasse Hallstrom's *Safe Haven*, a drama based on the best-selling novel by Nicholas Sparks and the thriller *Scenic Route*, which tells the story of two friends stranded in the desert. Other recent projects include George C. Wolfe's drama, *You're Not You* opposite Hillary Swank and Emmy Rossum, Garry Marshall's *New Year's Eve* alongside Michelle Pfeiffer, Robert DeNiro, Halle Berry, and Hilary Swank and Michael Bay's *Transformers: Dark of the Moon*, where he reprised his role of Captain William Lennox for the third installment of the franchise. Additional film credits include the romantic comedy *Life as We Know It* alongside Katherine Heigl, *Ramona and Beezus*, *When in Rome*, *Lost in the Sun*, *Bravetown* and *The Romantics*.

On television, Josh is known for his role as Danny McCoy on the NBC crime drama "Las Vegas." Additionally, he lent his voice to Nickelodeon's Emmy Award-winning animated series "Fanboy & Chum Chum" and starred in several seasons of the long-running ABC soap opera "All My Children," in which he received three consecutive Daytime Emmy nominations. Last year, he was seen in Vince Gilligan and David Shore's CBS series, "Battle Creek".

Duhamel currently resides in Los Angeles with his wife and son.

## **ERNIE HUDSON**

Ernie Hudson is one of the most sought-after actors of our time with an impressive list of credits and awards whose body of work has diverse range. He is a beloved star in film, television and stage, long considered one of the industry's most versatile actors who always delivers.

In his early years, Hudson served in the Marine Corps and then moved to Detroit, Michigan. He became the resident playwright at Concept East, the oldest black theatre company in the U.S. He established the Actors' Ensemble Theatre where he and other talented young black writers directed and appeared in their own works. Later, he enrolled and subsequently graduated from the Yale School of Drama.

Hudson first met Ivan Reitman on "Spacehunters." It wasn't long before he was asked to join Bill Murray, Dan Aykroyd and Harold Ramis in the 1984 feature film "Ghostbusters," gaining overnight fame playing 'Winston Zeddemore.' The 1989 sequel, "Ghostbusters 2," cemented Ernie's stardom as a film star when both pictures skyrocketed to box office gold, fan favorite standout blockbuster films.

A trio of critically lauded roles in diverse features soon followed including his critically lauded role as the mentally challenged 'Solomon' in "The Hand that Rocks the Cradle" to 'Munro' in "Congo" and 'Police Sgt. Albrecht' in the award-winning film, "The Crow." Hudson continued to expand industry attention by changing gears again showing amazing range in his role as 'Harry McDonald,' the FBI superior of Sandra Bullock's character in the feature film box office winner, "Miss Congeniality" (2000) and its hit sequel, "Miss Congeniality 2: Armed & Fabulous" in 2005.

Last year, Hudson has been singled out for his riveting role in Hilary Swank-directed "You're Not You" (eOne Films) with Emily Rossum, Josh Duhamel, Swank and Loretta Divine. Ernie reteamed with Duhamel again in the baseball drama, "The Wrong," due for release late 2016. Due to overwhelming studio and consumer demand, Ernie appears in a pivotal cameo in "Ghostbusters 3" (Sony) due for release July 15, 2016.

On the small screen, Hudson's wide range is most varied. Whether in memorable roles like 'Warden Leo Glynn' on HBO's lauded series "Oz" or the final season of "Law & Order, Ernie's ability to *become* the character is precisely what sets him apart from his peers. He has guest-starred on a myriad of shows from "Modern Family" and "Grey's Anatomy" to "Criminal Minds" and "Key and Peele" among others. He currently co-stars in Netflix's sophomore series "Grace & Frankie" opposite Lily Tomlin and Jane Fonda and will be seen this fall in a starring role on "Graves" (Epix) cast opposite Nick Nolte and Sela Ward.

The father of four strapping boys, Hudson divides his time between homes in Minneapolis and Los Angeles and giving back to the community whenever possible.

## **STERLING K. BROWN**

Veteran stage and screen actor Sterling K. Brown most recently starred as prosecutor Christopher Darden in FX's highly-rated television event series **THE PEOPLE V. O.J. SIMPSON: AMERICAN CRIME STORY**, for which he has earned an Emmy nomination. His performance was praised as riveting by *Deadline.com* and excellent by *The Hollywood Reporter*. Earlier this year, Brown co-starred alongside Tiny Fey in the feature film **WHISKEY TANGO FOXTROT**. He recently wrapped production on M. Night Shyamalan's feature film **SPLIT** and Open Road's drama **MARSHALL**. In August, Brown will co-star with Josh Duhamel in the biopic **SPACEMAN**. This fall, he will co-star in NBC's new dramedy series **THIS IS US** with Mandy Moore and Milo Ventimiglia.

A lover of theater, Brown has performed in a variety of staged shows, including the off-Broadway **FATHER COMES HOME FROM THE WARS (PARTS 1, 2 & 3)**, for which he reprised his role at the Mark Taper Forum in Los Angeles this spring. His additional stage credits include **MACBETH**, **THE BROTHER/SISTER PLAYS** and **THE RESISTABLE RISE OF ARTURO UI** opposite Al Pacino.

For seven years, Brown portrayed Dr. Roland Burton in the critically acclaimed Lifetime series **ARMY WIVES**. Additional television credits include **SUPERNATURAL**, **PERSON OF INTEREST**, **MASTERS OF SEX**, **THE MENTALIST**, **CASTLE** and **CRIMINAL MINDS**. His film credits include **OUR IDIOT BROTHER**, **THE SUSPECT**, **RIGHTEOUS KILL** and **TRUST THE MAN**.

Brown graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Drama from Stanford University, before receiving his Master's Degree in Fine Arts from NYU's Tisch School of the Arts. He currently resides in Los Angeles with his wife and two children.

## **WINTER AVE ZOLI**

A native of New Hope, Pennsylvania, Winter Ave Zoli has made a name for herself in exotic roles all over the world.

Winter was most recently seen starring opposite Sean Bean in the second series of the TNT show *Legends*. She played a high ranking Czech official whose fierce drive hides behind a free-spirited, bohemian laissez-faire attitude in the action packed drama.

Winter has recently completed production on two very different films. The thriller, *Deserted*, centers on a girl who returns to her small-town childhood home after being released from prison for killing her mother. The desire to go anywhere but be there prompts her to join her brother on a road trip out to Death Valley which results in them getting lost in the hostile and unforgiving terrain. The biopic *Spaceman* chronicles the downward spiral of Major League pitcher Billy Lee, a hot-tempered, self-serving madman unable to see himself as anything other than a baseball player. Josh Duhamel will play Lee with Zoli portraying his long suffering wife.

At age 12, Zoli began studying at Prague's International School where her parents moved to operate one of the city's most popular nightclubs, Radost FX. No coincidence, then that she'd eventually star on the FX Network, home to Kurt Sutter's critically acclaimed motorcycle club series, *Sons of Anarchy*. Zoli became a fan-favorite portraying the role of "Lyla" alongside the likes of Charlie Hunnam and Katey Sagal.

Having discovered theater and starred in numerous school productions, Zoli moved back across the pond to New York City to enroll in David Mamet's Atlantic Theater Company. Upon graduating, she returned to Prague with her family where she had the insight and good fortune of working on a handful of American productions including the Joel Schumacher films *Flawless* and *Bad Company*, Guillermo Del Toro's *Hellboy* and *The League of Extraordinary Gentlemen* with Sean Connery. It was during the latter when she was introduced to an American manager who was the impetus for her move to Los Angeles.

Additional film credits include *Tristan & Isolde* with James Franco, *The Oh in Ohio* with Paul Rudd, *Sex and Death 101* with Simon Baker, John Stockwell's Universal film *Cat Run* and the highly acclaimed short *Prodigal* with Sir Kenneth Branagh and Jennifer Morrison. She's accumulated an impressive amount of television appearances alongside her role in *Sons of Anarchy* including TNT's *Perception*, NBC's *Revelations* mini-series with Bill Pullman, A & E's *Scarlett Pimpernel* and most recently ABC's *Agents of SHIELD*.

Zoli currently resides in Los Angeles with her cat Munch, but travels avidly when not in production.
