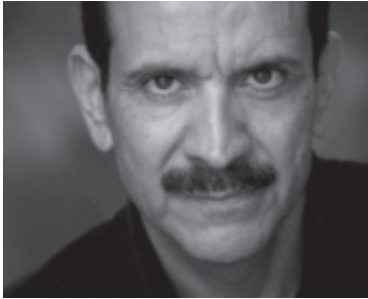
Clare Fetterappa is an actress, known for *The Danish Girl* (2015), *Brothers of War* (2015) and *Fresh Meat* (2011).
