Tragedy strikes, a superpower is revealed, and the hero must come to terms with their new abilities; a story arc of great comic book heroes. It's also the real life journey of a selfless 6-year-old cancer patient's desire to help others.

synopsis

In the typical comic book superhero story arc, tragedy strikes, a superpower is revealed, and the hero must come to terms with their new abilities all while not losing track of who they are. But how often is that lived out in real-life ... especially by a child?

Mable Tooke was diagnosed with cancer at age 4. As she endured chemotherapy, unique traits in her character started to develop ... characteristics that most people don't recognize until they are adults. Mable's empathy for others and her desire to control her destiny led to the creation of an alter ego and she soon saw her "wish" granted to fight crime with Spider-Man, save her city, and begin an adventure no one could have predicted ... as SpiderMable.

Mable's wish started the day as a charming local media story, transformed into the topic to be discussed across Canada, and travelled across the globe making headlines in countries tens of thousands of kilometers away. But that wasn't the most amazing part.

Mable's journey, followed for 5 years by a documentary crew, shows not only her battle against her biggest villain, cancer, but her potential for self-awareness, heroism, leadership, and inspiration from the most unsuspecting of people ... a small child.

directors biography



With a start behind the lens and 25 odd years as a cinematographer, **Kelly Wolfert** transitioned from that award-winning role to add writing and directing to his skillset. As an emerging filmmaker, Kelly soon realized he had to tackle the role of producer as well to complete some of his story ambitions. Years later, Kelly has now rounded out his storytelling skills to have written, directed, shot, and produced his first documentary feature film, “SpiderMable – a real life superhero story”, utilizing what he has been lucky to absorb from many colleagues over his career to complete a charming, northern Canadian-look at true heroism and leadership in a 6-year-old cancer patient’s journey to giveback to those that have helped her. Internationally experienced as a storyteller with projects

filmed in Japan, China, Russia, Chile, Peru, and Sweden, to name a few, his passion for sharing character driven stories has taught him to look around and just listen. That’s where he finds creative, socially relevant, inspiring ideas about the people that surround us everyday. Kelly has learned that people will be honest and vulnerable if they are being trusted and heard, and that is when human truths are revealed, making for compelling storytelling.

directors statement

I met Neil and Lisa Tooke’s daughter, Mable, while volunteering to produce a not-for-profit video for a fundraising event put on by The Children’s Wish Foundation of Canada. Mable, a 6-year-old in her second year of cancer treatment, was the leader of a team gathered to raise money for her wish ... anything she wanted. And was it ever a unique idea. In meeting this group of people and seeing the amazing work they do, it was an immediate “yes” when I was asked to help create Mable’s wish day – to fight crime with her hero, Spider-Man. In helping plan the story of the wish she was to live out, my colleagues and I decided to volunteer to film Mable’s wish not knowing it would become a global phenomenon. After watching and experiencing Mable’s wish with her, learning about the courageous and giving spirit of her and her family, it was a very easy decision to then start to turn her wish day into a short film. Little did we know what Mable would do the years following; living out the typical superhero story arc for real and giving back to those that had helped her. The years following that it took to tell this now 11-year-old’s story has introduced me to so many caregivers, philanthropists, and motivators, and it has been an honour to care for, cultivate, and shepherd this amazing young girl’s inspiring attitude and journey.
