SHORT SYNOPSIS

When nobody will believe that she's possessed, Anne (Sadie Katz) must take matters into her own hands, and exorcise the demon inside her on her own. Her only council is from a disgraced and defrocked priest (Vernon Wells).

Together they must solve the riddle of the demon that has haunted Anne's family for generations, taking both her mother and her grandfather before her. Now its latest victim, Anne realizes that if she can't free her family of this curse once and for all, her young son will be doomed to the same fate.

LONG SYNOPSIS

Anne (Sadie Katz) has it all: a loving husband, an adorable son, and a great career. But when her mother dies, Anne inherits the family curse. A demon that possesses one member of her family each generation. It lives inside them, using them up and killing them, before it skips to the next, younger generation of her family. This creature killed her mother. It killed her grandfather before that. Now it's inside Anne, and it's growing stronger and stronger.

Assuming that Anne is mentally ill and potentially dangerous, her husband Daniel takes their son Sam away from her. Anne is left to fight her demon on her own. Meantime Anne's possession episodes are becoming more and more severe. She's losing her battle against the demon.

With no one else to turn to, Anne reaches out to her old priest Father Geoffrey (Vernon Wells). Geoffrey has been defrocked for abusing children. But even the disgraced priest can't help her, and Anne decides to take matters into her own hands. She rents a cheap motel room, researches possession, gathers her materials, and sets out to perform an exorcism on herself. But the demon inside her has no intention of giving up, and Anne is in for the battle of her life if she's going to save her soul, and the soul of her son who will be the demon's next victim if she fails.
